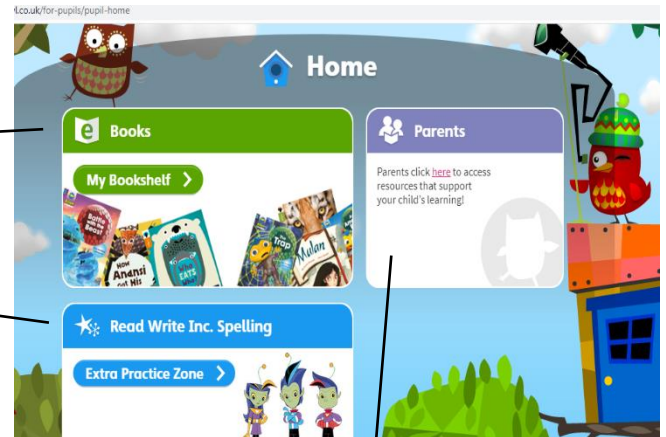

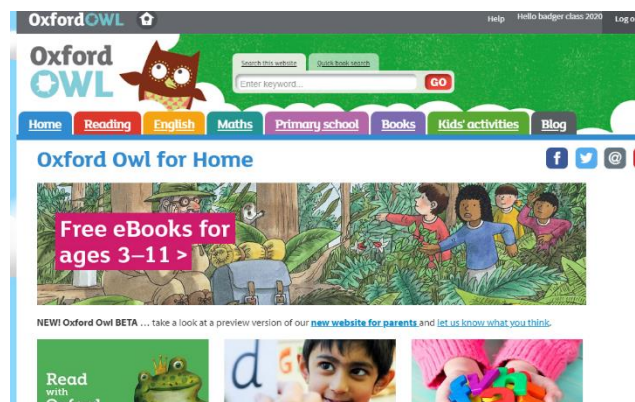

On this tab you can find out how to help your child develop confidence as a reader clicking on different age bands, choose books that are relevant for your child and different activities that relate to their reading

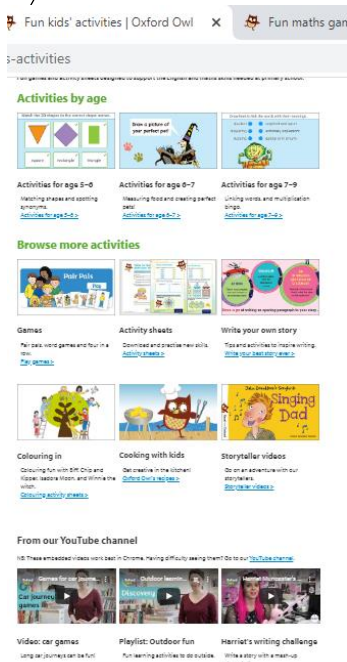
English

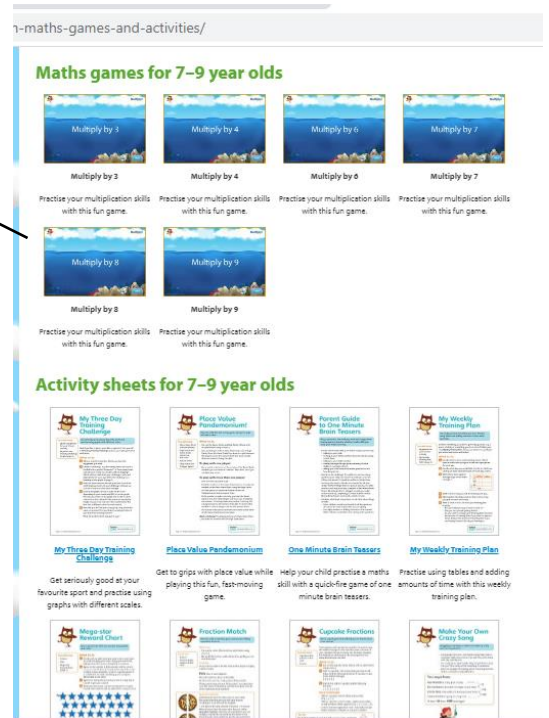
Maths

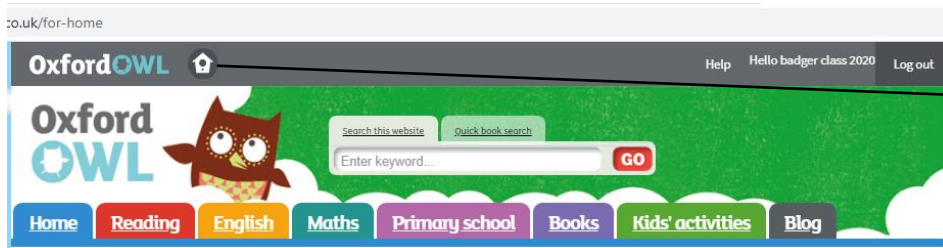
- On the **Primary School** tab you will find guides for each year group

- The **Blog** tab will take you to another website with more information on areas of school life



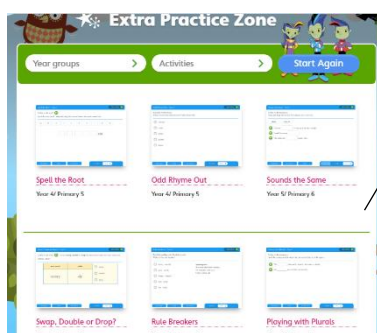
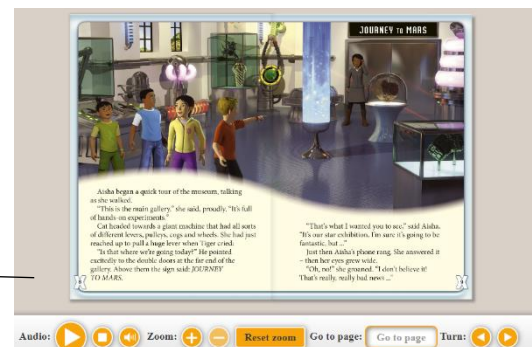
If you want to go right back to the initial page when you are on the website the you need to click on the bird house at the top of the webpage
