Next week is anti-bullying week. Anti-Bullying Week is coordinated in England and Wales by the Anti-Bullying Alliance and takes place from 15 to 19 November 2021. The theme this year is 'One Kind Word'. The week will begin with Odd Socks Day which is supported by CBBC and CBeebies star Andy Day and his band Andy and the Odd Socks and we will be supporting this by allowing children to come into school in odd socks or different coloured tights to our usual school uniform expectations. Children will still be expected to wear their usual school uniform apart from this change.

Kindness is more important today than it has ever been. The isolation of the last year has underlined how little acts of consideration can break down barriers and brighten the lives of the people around us. This is one of the reasons, that 'One Kind Word' has been chosen as the theme of Anti-Bullying Week. In keeping with this as a school we are changing the name of our anti bullying week to 'Cool To Be Kind Week.'

As part of the week children will take part in daily activities which focus on different ways to be kind to each other, consider how to be an upstander, how to be kind to our community and add thoughts to a kindness shout out display board among other things.

At end the week, on Friday 12th November, we will also be marking Children in Need. The school council have decided that to help raise money there will be different activities available for the children. Pupils can bring in a minimum contribution of £1 to come into school wearing children in need head bands or spotty bows whilst wearing school uniform. Each class will have a poster with Pudsey Bear faces on. The class that covers most faces with their pound coins will win a prize. At lunchtime, there will be an obstacle race in one of the playgrounds. Children can enter to take part in the obstacle race by paying 50p. Each race will be timed. The pupil with the winning time from each class will receive a Pudsey Prize!
