



ROAD SAFETY

THINK about where you should cross.

STOP in a safe place at the side of the road.

Use your **EYES AND EARS** to see and hear any approaching vehicles.

WAIT until any vehicles have passed.

LOOK AND LISTEN again to make sure all is clear.

CROSS the road. Keep looking and listening.



Last night, after multi-sports club, a child was almost knocked down when they ran into the road in front of a car. When the clocks go back it is important for us to remember that it is darker now and we need to ensure that children take extra care when crossing the road, and as adults we need to be extra vigilant too.

It will be road safety week in a couple of weeks time and we will be giving children reminders of how to stay safe on the roads. Parents play a big part in teaching their children how to cross the road safely during the evenings and weekends. Please take time to practice good road safety and ensure your child wears something fluorescent so that they can be seen on dark nights.
