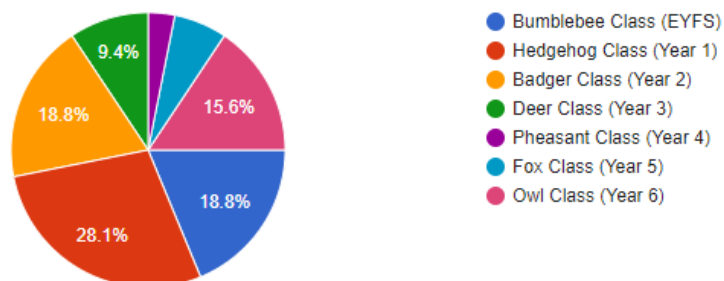

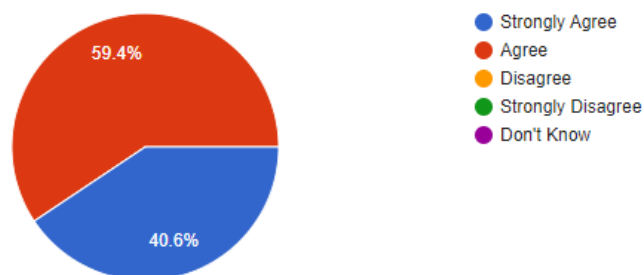

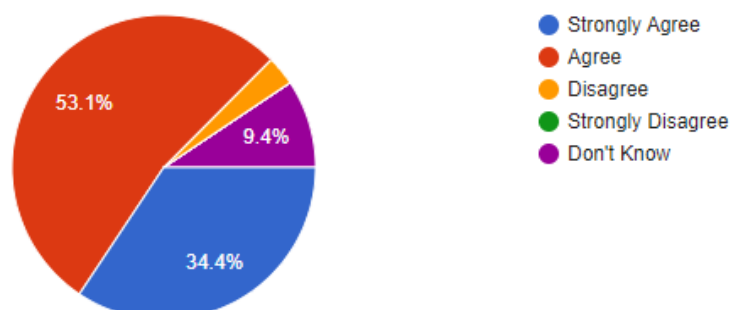
My child is happy at school

Through observations and discussions with the HT, DHT, SENCo, Finance Manager, T/L Leader, I feel the school is well led and managed.

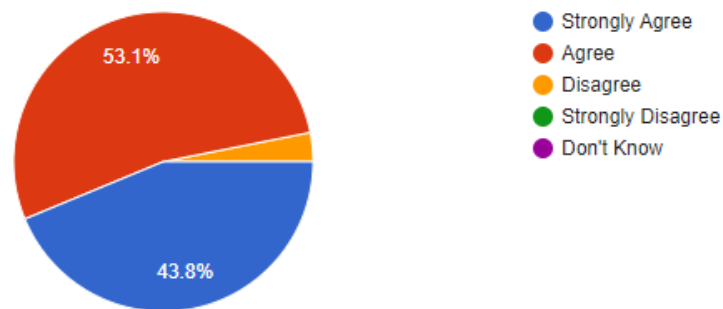

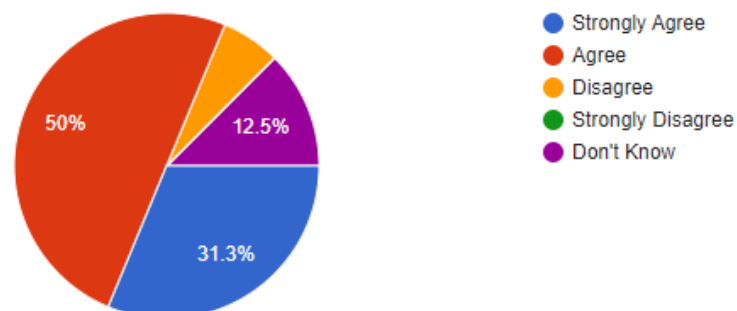
Through newsletters, assemblies, information on the website and discussions, I am confident that the school deals effectively with unacceptable behaviour and bullying, including cyberbullying.

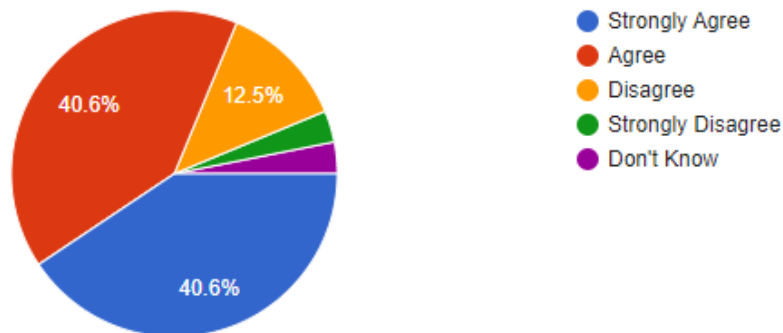

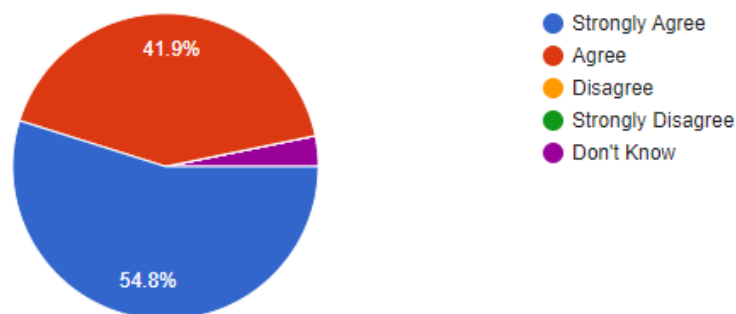

Christian Distinctiveness

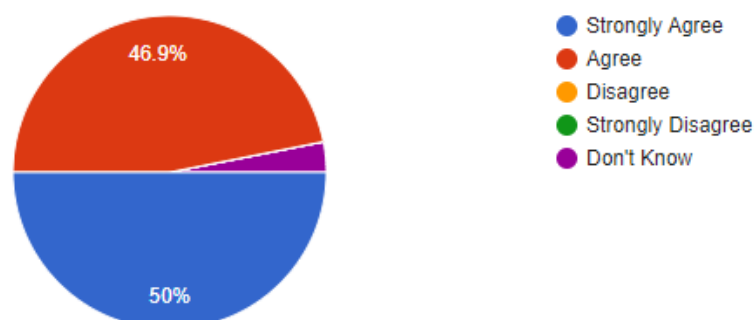
The school clearly communicates its Christian vision and values such as 'Hope' consistently through newsletters and other communications

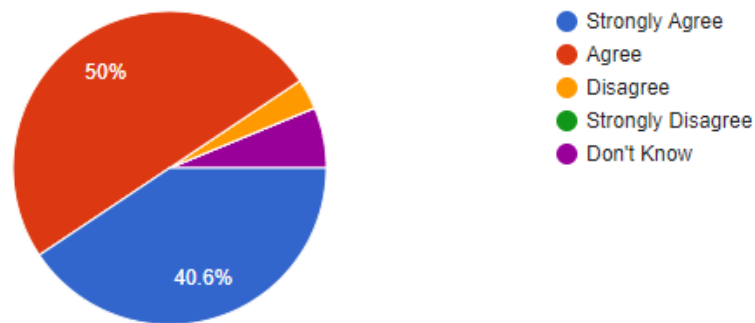

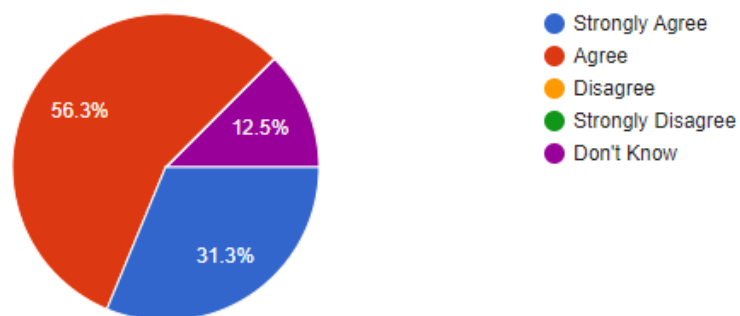
My child can relate Christian Values to how they should act eg.. what they say about environmental issues or raising money for charity

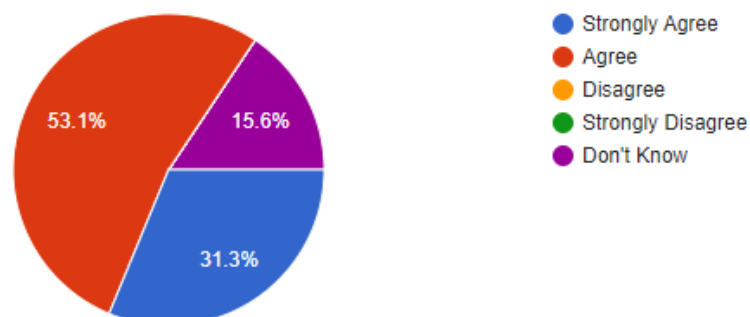

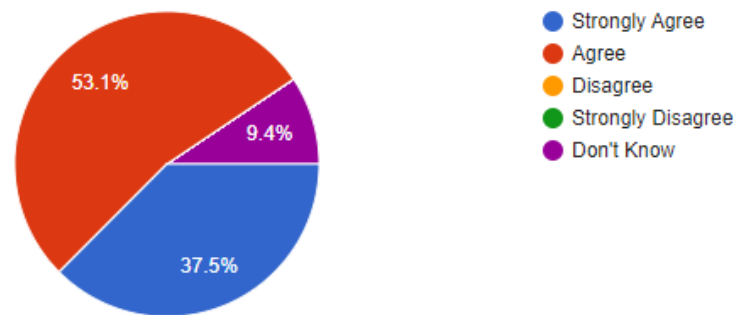

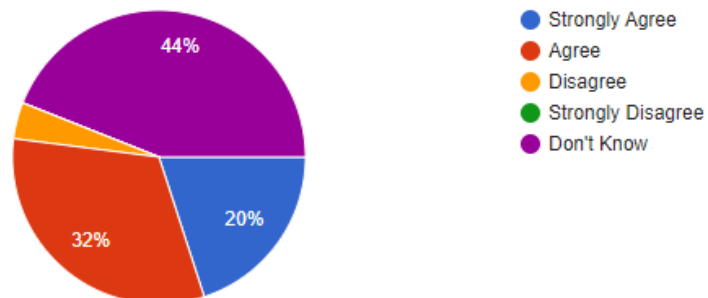

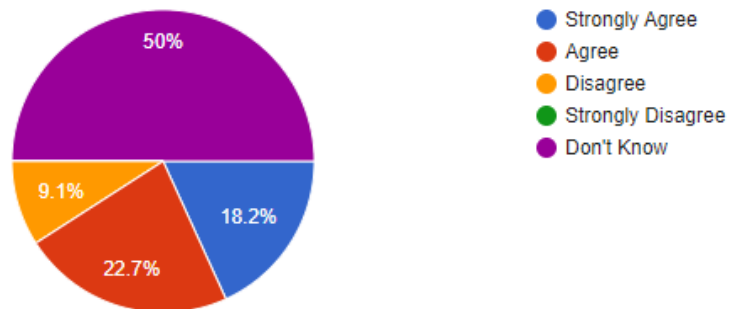

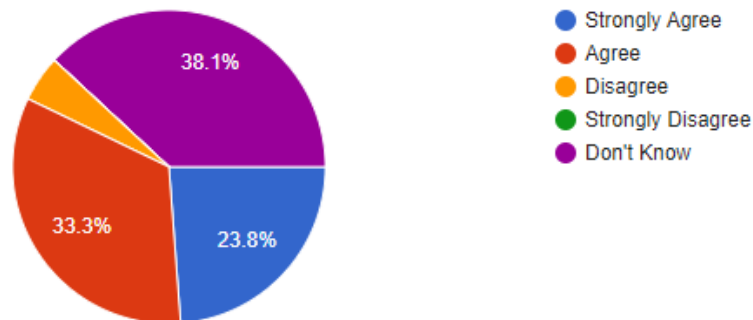
