Discovering Passions when reading stories

Re-read some books so children learn the language necessary to talk about what is happening in each illustration and relate it to their own lives

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Looking after others

Friendships

Show resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge.

Discuss why we take turns, wait politely, tidy up after ourselves and so on.

## Physical Development

Continue to develop correct letter formation and orientation

Use one hand consistently for fine motor tasks

Cut along a straight line with scissors

Start to cut along a curved line, like a circle / Draw a cross

Dance—move rhythmically to music, learn a simple sequence of moves

## Literacy

Reading stories from other cultures and traditions

Retell a story with actions and / or picture prompts as part of a group -

Use story language when acting out a narrative.

Rhyming words.

Explain the main events of a story - Can draw pictures of characters/ event / setting in a story. May include labels, sentences or captions.

Learning and distinguishing between uppercase and lowercase letters

Read and write set 2 sounds and use them within words and Sentences
